If my child is entering Junior High (grade 6, 7, or 8):

If my child is entering Senior High (grade 9, 10, 11, or 12\*):

- All report cards of work completed in senior high school and/or a transcript showing final grades
- Letter written by a leader in your church who knows both your family and your student. It is to be a recommendation as to the moral character of your family and, specifically, of your student.

For all full-time enrolling families:

- At least one parent and the entering student(s) must attend the interview.
- Relax and know that it is our privilege to meet you, even if you do not ultimately end up coming to Towle.
