Who should take the PSAT?

Those who will be <u>Sophomores</u> in the fall are encouraged to take this test as a practice for the SATs. The PSATs are often used as a benchmark in assessing the student's readiness for scholarships, summer internships and/or volunteer positions.

Likewise, those who will be *Juniors* in the fall are encouraged to take it in order to determine National Merit Scholarship status.

Freshmen are welcome to practice their test-taking abilities but please be forewarned that there is a lot of algebra in the math section of the PSAT.
